Requirements

1	The student must have a serious physical disability and may be "chair-confined" but does not have to be. The physical disability must be significant. No minor disability will be considered.
2	Must have serious financial need. (Total household income should not exceed \$10,000.00 unless number of household members is greater than 4.)
3	Must have at least a C+ average.
4	Must be a high school senior or currently enrolled in undergraduate studies. <i>We currently do not fund graduate studies</i>

ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE CONSIDERED WITHOUT REGARD TO SEX, RACE, or CREED.
Awards are for \$1,000-5,000 per year for each college year to a maximum of \$20,000 total.

You must include:

- A good recent photo.
- A 300-500 word essay outlining how you became physically challenged, how your situation has affected you and your family and also your goals and aspirations for the future.
- Three letters of recommendation.
- Include your Parent's or Guardian's Federal income tax return from last year. If you are on SSI or some other form of aid you must inform us. If your parents are divorced, you must send both tax returns.
- Send us your High School transcripts including your SAT and ACT scores and any honors or achievements you have earned
- Physician's documentation of your disability.
- If you have obtained any other scholarships already you MUST inform us of that fact.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS FEBRUARY 15TH.
